1. Schedule

Het event schedule is available at www.knzb.nl en www.swimcupeindhoven.nl

2. Standard times

The qualifying standards for the event need to be met in order to participate. There are separate standards for Para athletes. Both are available at www.knzb.nl and www.swimcupeindhoven.nl. Additional conditions for Dutch athletes are explained in the Dutch invitation and the website of the KNZB. These may include entries above the standard times. **Please be advised that is envisaged that the standard times for 2018 and on will be faster.**

3. Regulations Swim Cup Eindhoven 2017

3.1 Eligibility

- Entrytimes can be achieved on long course only, between January 1st 2016 and March 12th 2017 in official competitions under FINA regulations. It is mandatory that entry times can be verified.

3.2 Entries

- Entry deadline is Tuesday March 14th 23:59.
- Upon entering you will receive a confirmation twice:
 - An automatic confirmation that your e-mail was received
 - A personal message confirming your entry was processed. Only after receiving this second message your entries are accepted.
- You can send your entries via e-mail, please mention Entry swim cup EHV + your team name in the title.
- You need to send the SPLASH / Lenex data file, and the list of participants as a PDF file. You can make your registration complete, to add your contact info via Splash Team Manager, for which a separate manual on the KNZB website is available. You can request the number of team leader cards in the registration email to the office. You can download a non-license entry editor at:

- NB. All file names must be in the following format: yyyy-mm-dd=teamname-swimcup2017-inschr.lxf and yyyy-mm-dd=teamname-swimcup2017-inschr.pdf
- For paraswimmers the classification code must be included in the lxf files.

3.3 Ineligible, incomplete or late registrations.

- Unwarranted registration means:
 - times that do not fully correspond to the times in the report.
 - times that do not match the fastest time on the relevant event in the limit period.
 - times swum in competitions, of which no record is received at the KNZB.
- For all unauthorized entries, an administrative fee can be charged.

4 Heats, seeding and withdrawals

- All events will be swum in the open category of men and women.
- Heats will be swum in 10 lanes.
- The fastest heats of each event will be swum before the slowest heats of all events. A final seeding will be published in due times.
- Swimmers with disabilities will swim in the regular program, based on their entry times.
- 800 and 1.500 freestyle will have a timed final in the afternoon, swum on 8 lanes.
- All distances from 50 to 400 meters have an A and B final – 50, 100 and 200 freestyle a C-final.
- The eight fastest swimmers from the heats will qualify for the A-finals.
- The B-finals are for Dutch only – for 50, 100 and 200 freestyle this goes for the C-final, B-final will be open too.
- Withdrawals can be done until 24hrs before the first event at nkinschrijvingen@knzb.nl, where all competition days are considered as part of one competition. After publication of the entry lists, no refunds are applicable in case of withdrawal.

5 Finals; placement, withdrawals and reserves

- Finals will be swum on 8 lanes in the afternoon sessions.
- All A-finals are open for all. B-finals are for Dutch only. However on 50, 100 and 200 meter freestyle the B-final is open, as there is a C-final for these events. In this case the C-final is for Dutch athletes only.
- Please find an overview of qualification for the Final session at the end of this bulletin.
- Withdrawals can be done in writing at the resolution desk within 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the heats of the event concerned.
- For each final two reserves will be appointed.
- An athlete that does not want to be lined up as reserve must withdraw as well.

6 Paralympic athletes

- Parawimmers will be seeded in the heats according to entry times.
- The 8 athletes with the highest IPC point ranking will proceed to the final.
- The IPC-finals will be separate. There are IPC finals for 50, 100, 200 and 400m freestyle, 50 and 100m breaststroke, backstroke and butterfly, plus 200m individual medley.
- In case of fewer than 4 parawimmers, no final will be swum. The times of the heats will define the ranking.

7 Prizes

- The winner of each A-final being and the fastest heats on 800 and 1.500m freestyle will receive € 100,00. This does not apply to IPC finals in the B-final block.
- The cash prizes in the IPC finals in the A-final block will be awarded based on IPC points in the final session and not by class. NB: Parawimmers qualifying for 'regular' finals, will be ranked in the IPC point score as well and therewith are eligible for the prizes in IPC finals.

8 Tournament awards

The best athletes of the Swim Cup will receive prizemoney based on FINA rankings. The amount will be defined and published later. To be eligible for a tournament prize it is mandatory to attend the victory ceremony at the end of the last session.

9 Entry fee and payment

The entrance fee is € 10,00 per event, PLUS 3,50 per coach per day.

The fee of all foreign competitors must be paid by the start of the tournament at the information desk or via bank transfer before the event.
